The aforementioned information has to be provided due to the Act of 16 November 2012 amending the Act - Telecommunications Law - and other laws.

Terms and privacy policy concerning 'cookie files'

1. Wwww.wropak.pl website does not collect any information on an automatic basis. The only exception is the information contained in cookies.

2. Cookie files (so-called 'cookies') are text messages sent by a web server and stored on the user's end device. Default parameters of cookies allow reading the information contained therein only to the server that created them. Typically, cookies contain the name of the source website, storage time on the end device, and a unique number.

3. The following is the subject that stores cookies on the Website User's end device and has access to them:

4. Cookies are used on our website in order to:

- a) adapt the contents of a web page to user's preferences and optimize the use of websites, for example, show a website by adjusting its parameters to the characteristics of an end device;
- b) create statistics that help us analyze how users interact with the service;
- c) provide users with advertising content adapted to their interests, including remarketing.

5. The service uses two basic types of cookies:

- a) 'session' cookies are temporary information used to improve navigation, block users from entering false information and to collect statistical data from the website. This information will be deleted after closing the search engine or turning off the computer;
- b) 'permanent' cookies are stored in the user's end device for a time period specified in the parameters of cookies or until you delete them.

6. The service uses the following types of cookies:

- a) 'essential' cookies allow using the services available on the website, such as authentication cookies used for services that require authentication as part of the service;
- b) 'productive' cookies for collecting information about methods of using the administrator's websites;
- c) 'functional' cookies that 'save' user-selected settings and customize the user interface, for example, to automatically select a language or region of the user's origin, font size, appearance, website, etc.;
- d) 'advertising' cookies that allow providing the users with advertising content adapted to their interests.

7. In many cases, software used for browsing websites (the browser) allows storing cookies on users' end devices by default. However, the users can change these settings at any time. These settings can be changed to block the automatic handling of cookies in the browser settings or inform the user every time they are stored in the user's end device. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies is available in software settings (the browser).

8. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some functions available on the website.

9. Cookies can also be used by advertisers, research companies and multimedia applications providers as part of cooperation with our company.

If the user does not wish to receive cookies, the browser settings can be changed.

The web browser's settings can be changed to block cookies. However, please be informed that blocking cookies may adversely affect the ease of using websites or create difficulties when using certain website services.
